III ORGANISATION

Article 1.1 - ORGANISATION AND PROMOTION

The organiser and promoter of the Application Service Providers Kuitpo Forest Rally is the Southern Districts Car Club Inc.

The event shall be a State Championship Special Stage Rally conducted under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), the National Rally Code, 2011 SA Conditions of Rallying, 2011 SARC Series Supplementary Regulations, these Event Regulations and any Further Regulations which may be issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

This event will be run using A to A timing as per National Rally Code 1.33

Insurance for the event shall be in accordance with Appendix I of the 2011 CAMS Manual.

McLeod Medal Award

In honour of Stewart McLeod, six times winner of the South Australian Rally Championship.

Eligibility: driver or co-driver must be a bona fide resident of South Australia and a current financial member of a South Australian club; or be a member of Barrier Sporting Car Club. Competitors must be in their first calendar year of rallying at State Championship level and must not have competed at that level anywhere else.

Lincoln Harding Memorial Award

Is an award to encourage drivers to continue to develop and improve their skills.

Eligibility: All drivers named in the Drivers Performance Index (DPI) as per the 2011 Conditions of Rallying for South Australia.

Steve Winwood Trophy (as per Series Regulations)

Article 3 – Event Details (as per Series Regulations plus the following)

Article 3.3 The CAMS Permit Number authorising the event is 511/3010/02

The SA Rally Championship will be approximately 220km, including 9 Special Stages and 3 Super Special Stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately 140 km. All special stages are of a gravel/dirt surface, held in the Southern Hills area on a combination of Forestry SA and Lanac Park.

The SA Clubman Series will be approximately 150km, including 6 Special Stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately 90km. All special stages are of a gravel/dirt surface, held in the Southern Hills area on a combination of Forestry SA.

Article 4 – Vehicle Eligibility – as per series regulations

Article 5 - COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY (as per Series Regulations plus the following)

Article 5.1

All competitors holding a minimum of a CAMS Clubman Rally Licence are eligible to enter.

Competitors wishing to score points for the current South Australian Rally Championship **MUST**

- Have registered and paid for the championship with CAMS (Refer Appendix II)
- Display the series sponsor stickers on the competing vehicle at all times throughout the event. Failure to do so will result in a report to the Stewards. Recommended penalty will be annulment of any points scored towards the SARC. Stickers will be available at pre-event scrutiny, if required. Placement & details are as per SARP directive.

Article 6 - ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE (as per Series Regulations plus the following)

Article 6.6 The number of entries will be limited to 50 entries. If this limit is exceeded preference will be given to drivers who have registered for the current South Australian Rally Championship and then in order of receipt of fully completed and fully paid entry form. The organisers may establish a waiting list. (In order of receipt of fully completed, and fully paid entry form).

Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83.

Article 6.7 The starting order will be as specified in the 2011 Conditions of Rallying for South Australia. Drivers without a current DPI listing will be seeded at the Clerk of Course's discretion.

Seeding for the SA Clubman Series will be by the current clubman DPI and at the Clerk of Course's discretion.

Article 6.8 - 6.14 Refer Series Standing Regulations.

Article 7 - SERVICING AND REFUELLING (as per Series Regulations plus the following)

Article 7.1 The maximum distance between nominated Service Parks and refuel zones will be approximately 75 km.(including approximately 45 km competitive).

Article 7.2 PULP Fuel will be available at the following locations: - Meadows

Article 7.3 Servicing & re-fuelling are only permitted in the designated service park located at Meadows Oval. At NO OTHER TIME OR PLACE will service or re-fuelling, be permitted.

Article 7.4 – 7.6 Refer to Series Regulations

Article 7.7 A Timed service park will be used as indicated in the rally itinerary with a Time Control at the entrance and exit.

Article 7.8 The speed of cars in the service parks must not exceed walking pace; offenders will be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting, the recommended penalty will be 5 minutes per offence.

Article 7.9 Fuel shall be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

Article 8 - RECONNAISSANCE AND PACE NOTING (as per Series Regulations plus the following)

Article 8.1 Crews are only permitted to cover each stage a maximum of TWO (2) times.

Article 8.2 Crews are reminded that Council, Private and Forest roads used in the rally will not be closed during reconnaissance. **Crews must comply with recce speed limits of 60km/h or the posted limit whichever is lower whilst on Forestry Stages.** Any breach of this regulation will result in a penalty recommendation to the stewards. The penalty recommendation will be up to exclusion.

Article 8.3 Under NO circumstances are crews to travel in the opposite direction to the set course on Special Stages.

Article 8.4 -8.7 Refer to the Series Regulations

Article 8.8 Any member of the crew found on the course in the period two months prior to the start of the rally (**with the exclusion of Lanac Park**), with the exception of the period allowed for reconnaissance as per these regulations, will be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of exclusion, unless written approval from Organisers has been obtained.

Article 8.9 & 8.10 Refer to the Series Regulations

Article 9 - Odometer check

The Official Odometer check has been changed due to the old finish being in a NO STANDING zone. We have also set official checks in the South and North.

a. City

The new official odometer check in the City is done by travelling East along Greenhill Rd between two marked power poles and is 5.64km long.

The Start pole is situated 100m West of Goodwood Rd. It has a sign stating "ODO Start" in white letters on a red background.

The end pole is situated east of Burke St (directly opposite Laurel Ave). It is marked "ODO Finish" in white letters on a red background.

b. South

The new official odometer check in the South is done by travelling South along South Rd between two marked power poles and is 4.16km long.

The Start pole is situated approx 280m South of Sherriffs Rd/Pimpala Rd (directly opposite Stanley Ct). It has a sign stating "ODO Start" in white letters on a red background.

The end pole is situated 270m South of Greengate Gr. It is marked "ODO Finish" in white letters on a red background.

c. North

The new official odometer check in the North is done by travelling North West along McIntyre Rd between two marked poles and is 4.96km long.

The Start pole is situated approx 200m North of Montague Rd (3rd light pole). It has a sign stating "ODO Start" in white letters on a red background.

The end pole is situated 150m East of Booloo St (79 McIntyre Rd). It is marked "ODO Finish" in white letters on a red background

IV DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINY

Article 10 DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY (as per Series Regulations plus the following)

- Article 10.1** Documentation will be available during the following times 1830-2030 hours and must be completed prior to presentation of that vehicle for scrutiny –
Vehicles must be presented for scrutiny at S&J Automotive 33 Woodlands Terrace Edwardstown Adelaide SA..
- Article 10.2** Scrutiny and Documentation will be held on Thursday 27th Oct 2011, 1900 hrs - 2200 hrs (unless granted an exemption by Clerk of Course).
- Article 10.3** Vehicles requiring re-scrutiny, or those vehicles granted an exemption are required to attend scrutiny at Lanac Park between 1400 hrs and 1530 hrs on Saturday 29th Oct 2011.
- Article 10.4** Turbo Scrutiny will be held for all vehicles fitted with a turbocharger on Thursday 27th Oct 2011 from 1900 hrs until 2100 hrs at the scrutiny venue.
- Article 10.5** Current CAMS Competition Licence and passbook of BOTH crew members must be presented along with vehicle logbook (if issued) and CAMS club membership card.
- Article 10.6 – 10.10** Refer to the Series Regulation
- Article 10.11** Post event scrutiny will take place within 1 hour of the selected vehicle finishing the event. Those crews concerned will be advised on arrival at the final Parc Ferme.

Parc Ferme will be located at Meadows Oval, where all vehicles will be held until post event scrutiny has been completed and the Stewards allow them to be removed.

Article 11 – START (as per Series Regulations plus the following)

- Article 11.1** Both driver and co-driver for the SARC **MUST** be present at Competitors' briefing at **1530 hrs on Saturday 29th Oct 2011. To be held at the Lanac Park.**

Both driver and co-driver for the SACS **MUST** be present at Competitors' briefing at **0900 hrs on Sunday 30th Oct 2011. To be held at the Meadows Oval**
- Article 11.2** The Rally will start at **1600 hrs on Saturday 29th Oct 2011** and the first SARC car will finish at approx **1600 hrs on Sunday 30th Oct 2011 at Meadows.**
- Article 11.3** Any competitor failing to complete the Super Special Stage at Lanac Park will be given a derived time of 5 minutes. This includes not completing the correct course as per the road book.
- Article 11.4** Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
